#### **Suggestions for Getting Started**

- 1. **Build Your Team.** Invite your friends and neighbors to join you for an introductory AdvaNCe Team meeting to learn more about Women AdvaNCe. Identify your contacts who share an interest in issues affecting North Carolina women and families. You may already have an ideal group formed, like a book club or scrapbooking club, which could double as your AdvaNCe Team.
- 2. **Set a Regular Meeting Date.** Select a date and time that will work best for your group. Help team members prioritize your monthly meetings by setting up a reminder e-mail or phone call a few days before you meet each month.
- 3. Always Keep Your Team Goals Handy. Within this packet is a Team Goals sheet outlining the important ways your team can help Women AdvaNCe extend our reach. This packet also includes a 2014 Team Checklist, offering a variety of important action items your team can choose from throughout the year to impact change in our state.
- 4. **Enjoy Yourself**. Incorporate some food and fun activities into your AdvaNCe Team meetings to keep your team going for the long run.
- 5. **Be Proud.** Your team is part of a statewide effort to help North Carolina women take action and create change together.

#### **Introductory Meeting Itinerary:**

- Guests arrive: Offer sign in sheets to help gather your team's contact information. Offer name tags if your team isn't already familiar with each other.
- Food & Friends: Offer a light snack, allowing guests 30 minutes to greet and eat.
- Host Introduction: Explain to guests why you decided to start an AdvaNCe Team.
- Invite guests to join your AdvaNCe Team: Review Team Goals sheet. Ask each member to sign up at www.WomenAdvanceNC.org/start-your-advance-team, listing you as the team lead.
- **Q&A:** Show guests the Women AdvaNCe website and help answer their questions about getting connected with our e-mail subscription and social media.
- Complete Survey: Answer the Women AdvaNCe three-question survey as a group.
- Plan Your Action: Discuss opportunities for your group to take action together, using the 2014 AdvaNCe Team Actions Checklist. Women AdvaNCe will announce coordinated action plans in early 2014.
- Wrap-Up: Set a date for your next AdvaNCe Team meeting and thank guests for coming.
- **Timing:** A 2-hour timeframe works well for introductory meetings.



#### **TEAM GOALS**

#### Your team's actions will help grow the Women AdvaNCe community:

- 1. **Form Your Team:** Host an AdvaNCe Team Meeting and join the movement on-line.
  - o **Follow Women AdvaNCe** by reading our articles about issues affecting NC women.
  - o **Share what you learn** through your personal conversations, e-mails, and social media.
  - o **Meet monthly as a group** to discuss issues addressed in Women AdvaNCe articles.
  - Take action together and track your team's progress on your 2014 AdvaNCe Team
     Actions Checklist, included in this kit. Women AdvaNCe will be introducing
     coordinated, statewide activities in 2014, to help teams act together, across our state.
- 2. **Spark the Movement:** Each one, reach one. This is important! Ask each of your team members to help other North Carolina women start new AdvaNCe Teams.
  - o Help someone in your own county start an AdvaNCe Team.
  - Help someone in a different North Carolina county start an AdvaNCe Team, if possible.
- 3. **Generate Some Buzz:** Send in content for Women AdvaNCe to share: Info@WomenAdvanceNC.org
  - o **Take a picture** of your group at your first meeting.
  - o **Give us feedback** about articles you like and issues you care about.
- 4. Connect as a State: Plan to attend the 2014 NC Women's Summit date to be announced.
  - Attend as an individual or as an AdvaNCe Team.
  - Learn from progressive women leaders in North Carolina.
  - Make meaningful connections with women from across NC.

Encourage them to stay up-to-date on important issues by signing up for our e-news subscription (look for the purple button at the top right corner of our website). Include people from your guest list who weren't able to make it to your introductory meeting.
